The residence hall program and the student services department provide guidelines supporting the development of a strong Christian value system and lifestyle. Each student will receive a copy of the *Student Handbook* and the residence hall packet of information and policies when they move into the residence halls.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Each residence hall room is fully equipped with the following items:

- Two twin beds/bunk beds
- Closets and dressers
- Desks and chairs
- Window coverings [except Newton and Grainger]
- Rooms are wired with two 10/100 MB Ethernet connections. You will need to supply the computer and network card. Visit <http://itss.puc.edu> for requirements and how to get connected.

Each residence hall has the following facilities:

- Coin-operated laundry
- Ironing boards
- Pay phones [except McReynolds]
- Kitchens or cooking areas
- Parlors
- Study rooms [except men's residence halls]
- Bike storage areas [except Grainger and Newton]

WHAT TO BRING

When you are planning what to pack and bring with you from home, consider the following items:

- Desk lamp
- Bedding: mattress cover, linens, etc.
- Wastebasket
- Cleaning supplies and small vacuum
- Telephone
- Headphones, ear phones
- Iron
- Airtight food storage containers
- Room decor to reflect a Christian atmosphere

OPTIONAL ITEMS

Appliances: coffee maker, rice cooker, blender, microwave, hot pot with enclosed heating elements, micro refrigerator

Carpet: All dorm rooms are carpeted with the exception of rooms in Andre Hall and the old wing of Winning Hall. You may provide carpet for Andre and Winning if desired. We recommend 10' x 12' carpet for these rooms.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Your own furniture
- Pets [only exception are fish]
- Halogen lamps
- Extension cords (cords with internal circuit breakers only)
