This sheet outlines the course equivalencies for Pacific Union College students who study in Lebanon (Middle East University) through the Adventist Colleges Abroad program.

General Education Coursework

Arabic Language Coursework	VIII: Language (Required for BA Degree only)

Major or Minor Coursework

If you are taking a major or minor in Arabic, you should plan to complete the following language coursework in Lebanon. Please consult with your advisor or review the General Catalog for additional information regarding program requirements.

Major in Language and Culture Studies, Arabic Emphasis: Take at least 25 hours of ARAB courses (any level), including ARAB 260 Current Events in the Arab World, or ARAB 270 Arab People and their Culture.

Minor in Arabic: Take ARAB 111 Basic Grammar II, ARAB 121 Basic Conversation II, ARAB 131 Basic Writing II, and ARAB 141 Basic Reading II. Also take either ARAB 260 Current Events in the Arab World or ARAB 270 Arab People and their Culture.

Electives

All other courses taken in Lebanon will be applied as general electives.
