Major or Minor Coursework

If you are taking a major or minor in Italian, you should plan to complete the following language coursework in Italy. Please consult with your advisor or review the General Catalog for additional information regarding program requirements.

Major in Language and Culture Studies, Italian Emphasis: Take at least 30 hours of ITLN courses at the intermediate level or higher. Include at least 24 hours of upper-division coursework.

Minor in Italian: Take at least 24 hours of ITLN courses at the intermediate level or higher. Include at least 8 hours of upper-division coursework.

Electives

All other courses taken in Italy will be applied as general electives.
