Rules to Live By



Attendance is required to all sponsored classes, programs and events, unless it is scheduled *free time* or, in case of illness or emergency.

I will respect the property, personal dignity, time, and right to privacy of others. No guests of the opposite gender allowed in dorm rooms at any time. I will refrain from using vulgar or inappropriate language during my stay at PacificQuest.

I will be in my dorm room by 10 p.m. each night. Check in is required with your counselor.

Illegal drugs, fireworks, explosives and all weapons are prohibited on the College campus. Misuse or abuse of prescription drugs is neither acceptable nor tolerated.

I will stay in the main campus area and will let my counselor know where I am at all times.

I will not approach or attempt to feed any wildlife on campus.

If I have any health issues or require special accommodations, I will inform the Academic and/or Camp Director before I arrive, so necessary arrangements can be made.

The College assumes no responsibility for a participant's personal property; so I will leave my valuables behind.

Bottom line, do NOT do anything your parents, grandparents, pastors, teachers, principal, or neighbors would not approve of. Remember the *Golden Rule*.

Conduct Agreement: I choose to abide by the rules as outlined above for the duration of my stay at PacificQuest 2011.

I understand if I fail to abide by these rules, I will be dismissed from the program immediately and my parents will be contacted, to make arrangements for my return home, at my own expense.
