

Freshmen Scholarships & Awards 2015-2016

Maxwell Scholar Program*

Deadline: Complete application packets must be received or postmarked by March 2, 2015

Application: puc.edu/maxwellscholar

The Maxwell Scholar Program awards **\$15,000** renewable scholarships to five winners and **\$12,000** renewable scholarships to five runners-up. Winners are selected based on academic success, leadership experience, and Christian service. Candidates must be incoming freshmen, have a 3.5-4.0 GPA and 26+ ACT or 1700+ SAT, and submit an application that includes an essay and letters of recommendation.

5 Winners - **\$15,000** (renewable with a 3.5 GPA) / 4-Year Total: **\$60,000**

5 Runners-up - **\$12,000** (renewable with a 3.5 GPA) / 4-Year Total: **\$48,000**

President's and Dean's Scholarships*

Deadline: None; information must be submitted in order to receive award

Application: Submit academic transcripts and test scores to the PUC office of admissions

The President's and Dean's Scholarships are awarded to incoming freshmen and are based on unweighted cumulative GPA or test-scores. (Both scholarships are renewable with a 3.5 GPA.)

President's Scholarship

3.75-4.0 GPA or 29+ ACT / 1900+ SAT

\$10,000 / 4-Year Total: **\$40,000**

Dean's Scholarship

3.5-3.74 GPA or 26+ ACT / 1700+ SAT

\$9,000 / 4-Year Total: **\$36,000**

Pacific Union College recognizes the achievement and potential of incoming students through significant merit-based awards. Each incoming student will receive the single highest academic award (noted by "**") for which they qualify. The academic award can be combined with the various scholarships and discounts listed on the other side of this page.

Academic Achievement Scholarships*

Deadline: None; information must be submitted in order to receive award

Application: Submit academic transcripts to the PUC office of admissions

The amount awarded in the first year at PUC will renew at the same amount for the next three years.

Award amounts are based on high school unweighted cumulative GPA.

The Mostert Christian Leaders Scholarship awards 30 renewable **\$2,000** scholarships to incoming freshmen who have demonstrated exceptional leadership in their schools, churches, or communities.

Adventist Mission Scholarship

Deadline: None; information must be submitted in order to receive award

Future pastors majoring in theology or teachers actively pursuing a teaching credential for elementary or secondary education receive a renewable **\$3,000** grant.

Creative Arts Scholarship

Deadline: Complete application must be received or postmarked by March 2, 2015

Application: puc.edu/scholarships

Students who excel in visual arts, music, or drama may apply for an Creative Arts Scholarship. Selected students will receive a renewable **\$3,000** scholarship. Students must declare a visual arts major; an A.S. in film and theater studies; or participate in one of the music department's official performing groups. See applications for more details.

Freshmen International students who have a GPA above a 3.0 may submit an application.

Seventh-day Adventist Church Scholarships

PUC offers the following opportunities as a commitment to supporting a new generation of leaders for the Adventist church.

PUC/NAD 100 Percent Free Tuition Partnership

PUC offers **100 percent** free tuition for students with a parent serving the SDA church through denominational employment. Students must have at least one parent who receives NAD tuition assistance (per NAD Working Policy, Y 24 05) at 70 percent of PUC's tuition cost to be eligible. Participation in this plan may result in ineligibility for other PUC financial aid. Student must reside in the dormitory to be eligible.

Summer Ministries Leadership Match

PUC matches **100 percent** of certified earnings that are applied to tuition by students who work at a SDA youth camp or in a youth ministry program in the summer prior to Fall quarter enrollment, up to **\$2,000**.

Summer Literature Evangelism Match

PUC matches **100 percent** of certified earnings that are applied to tuition by students who work as SDA literature evangelists in the summer prior to Fall quarter enrollment, up to **\$3,000**.

Student Missions/Task Force Scholarships

These awards are available to qualified students who attend PUC the year following their service and are based on length of service.

Pacific Union Conference Education Endowment and Minority Scholarships

These awards are available through local SDA churches and conferences. Contact your pastor or local conference Office of Education for an application.

Discounts

Advanced Payment Discount

A **7 percent** discount is available to students who pay the year's balance in advance at Fall quarter registration (discount is pro-rated over three terms of the regular school year). A **2 percent** discount is available to students who pay the quarter-in-advance at each term's registration. These discounts are calculated on charges less all aid (including loans).

Family Discount

An immediate family with two dependent students attending PUC at the same time will receive a tuition-only discount of **\$300** per student, per quarter; with three or more students, the discount is **\$350** per student, per quarter.

General Scholarship & Awards Guidelines

These scholarships are for full-time students on the Angwin campus only.

All PUC scholarships, awards and discounts cannot exceed costs for tuition and technology fee.

Scholarships and awards will be applied to the student's account at the rate of one-third of the total per quarter and are available for full-time students only.

Loss of scholarship money may result when a student does not maintain the minimum cumulative GPA required by the particular scholarship or federal guidelines.

If part of the freshman year has been taken at another college, partial freshman year scholarships will be awarded.

The last day of final tests for the first quarter that a student in enrolled at PUC is the deadline for verifying with Student Financial Services that the student qualifies for a scholarship for the academic year.
