In its continued commitment to promoting diversity on campus, Pacific Union College presents 10 annual Minority Leadership Scholarships. These scholarships are awarded to students who have demonstrated leadership have a history of serving their community and a commitment to future leadership and service. These scholarships of \$1,050 each, are renewable on a yearly basis. Renewal is subject to submitting a reapplication, the student remaining in good standing at PUC, and maintaining at least a 2.5 GPA. Special consideration will be given to students who come from disadvantaged backgrounds.

I. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Please complete this application and mail it with the following items:

1. An essay outlining a brief personal history, reasons for wanting to attend PUC, and how you plan to serve your community as a future professional. The essay should be typed, double spaced (not to exceed two pages). You may also choose to include a curriculum vitae of your leadership experience and academic achievements.
2. Transcript(s) of your grades for all high school and college courses taken.
3. Two letters of recommendation. The letters should be written by a teacher, pastor, counselor or another person who can assess your character, leadership experience, as well as your academic performance. The letters of recommendation may not be written by anyone related to you.
