

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN PACIFIC UNION COLLEGE DEGREE COMPLETION PROGRAM (DCP)
AND BARSTOW COLLEGE
FOR BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION (ECE)

All students who wish to receive a Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education (ECE) from Pacific Union College's Degree Completion Program (DCP) must satisfy the requirements in the following three areas:

- ECE Major Coursework (Consists of 60 quarter-units which are earned in the Degree Completion Program)
- ECE Foundational Coursework (Described below- required for admission to program)
- General Education Coursework (Described below)

Finally, students must earn enough additional elective credit to have a total of at least 192 quarter-units of college coursework.

Transfer students with questions are encouraged to contact the DCP office at (707) 965-6505. Transfer students need not fulfill all below requirements before transferring into the DCP program; however, a minimum of 90 quarter-units including the ECE Foundational Coursework should be earned before transferring. All requirements must be completed in order to graduate from Pacific Union College.

ELECTIVE CREDIT

Required: Additional units needed to make 192 total quarter-units

Any transferable courses (courses numbered 1-49), excluding work experience. A maximum of 16 quarter-units of vocational/technical credit are transferable.

GENERAL EDUCATION ELECTIVES

A minimum of 19 quarter-units must be earned **in addition** to meeting all the specific GE requirements.

The 19 units must be chosen from at least 4 of the below 7 categories and no more than 10 quarter-units can come from any 1 category. Any 1 course cannot count in multiple categories.
