General Information

Each residence hall room is fully equipped with the following items:

- Two twin beds/bunk beds
- Closets and dressers
- Desks and chairs
- Window coverings (except Newton and Grainger)
- Two 10/100 MB Ethernet connections. Network card not provided. See itss.puc.edu for more information.

Each residence hall has the following facilities:

- Coin-operated laundry (save those quarters!)
- Ironing boards
- Kitchens or cooking areas
- Lobbies, study rooms
- Outdoor bike racks

What to Pack

Can't fit your entire room into the minivan? Put down the packing tape and take a moment to read over our recommended packing list. Once you know the essentials for survival and what's not allowed, you might think twice about hauling your grandma's floral couch up Howell Mountain Road.

Must Haves:

- Desk lamp
- Bedding, including mattress cover
- Wastebasket
- Cleaning supplies for the room and bathroom
- Small vacuum
- Telephone
- Iron
- Appropriate decorations to show your personality
- Photos of family and friends
- Computer and network card
- Ear buds or headphones

Kinda Must Haves:

- Microwave
- Mini-fridge (four cubic feet or less)
- Rice cooker
- Blender
- Hot pot with enclosed heating elements

(More on back)

- Carpet or rug (all dorm rooms are carpeted with the exception of rooms in Andre Hall and the north wing of Winning Hall. You may bring carpet for Andre or Winning if desired. We recommend 10' x 12' carpet for these rooms)

Cannot Haves:

- Your own furniture
- Pets (only exception are fish)
- Halogen lamps
- Extension cords (cords with internal circuit breakers only)

- Toasters & toaster ovens
- Hot plates

BTW

All rooms have a phone jack for you to hook up your landline. All campus calls are free, but off-campus/long-distance service is only available on a pre-paid basis from the Information Technology department.

If you plan on using a cell phone at PUC, Verizon is the only service that works on the hill.
