PUC APPOINTS TAMARA TIRADO AS NEW DEAN OF NURSING AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

Pacific Union College is pleased to announce that Dr. Tamara Tirado has been appointed as the new Dean of Nursing and Emergency Management. Dr. Tirado holds a Doctor of Nursing Practice from Loma Linda University, a master's in nursing and family nurse practitioner from Sonoma State University, and both bachelor's and associate degrees in nursing from Pacific Union College. Serving as the BSN Program Manager and Professor of Nursing, Dr. Tirado has dedicated 17 years to PUC, bringing knowledge and experience in curriculum development, accreditation, student success initiatives, faculty mentorship, and committee service across the college.
