### How to Register:

2. Download and complete the Tuition Waiver form and have it signed by the conference superintendent BEFORE uploading with class registration.
3. Complete all required information.
4. Upload signed tuition waiver authorization form before submitting registration.
5. **Please Note:** The PUC Records office will not release your transcript to the Union Office of Education without a signed waiver. If you have any concerns regarding renewal credit for certification, first check with PUC Records to make sure they have your approved waiver.

### General Info:

1. The tuition waivers cover 12 credits per summer (usually equivalent to 4 classes).
2. Instructors will email textbook information and course details in a welcome email several weeks prior to the start of class along with how to access Canvas.
3. Canvas is the online platform for the classes.
4. Synchronous means meeting live on Zoom or Teams during the times indicated.
5. Asynchronous means no live meetings – working through online modules with readings, discussions, and learning activities on your own time generally at your pace within the start and end time of the class.
