From San Francisco International Airport

1. Go north on **U.S. 101**. Follow signs to the Bay Bridge (**U.S. 80** east) toward Sacramento.
2. Take **U.S. 80** east after crossing the Bay Bridge. Cross the Carquinez Bridge.
3. Turn off at the Napa, Marine World exit onto **HWY 37**.
4. From **HWY 37** turn right (going north) on **HWY 29**.
5. Continue through the towns of Napa, Yountville, Oakville, Rutherford, and St. Helena. One mile past St. Helena, turn right on **Deer Park Road**, which turns into Howell Mountain Road. (8 miles to PUC).

From Oakland International Airport

1. Take **HWY 880** north.
2. Merge onto **U.S. 80** east toward Sacramento.
3. Follow directions in numbers 2-5 above.

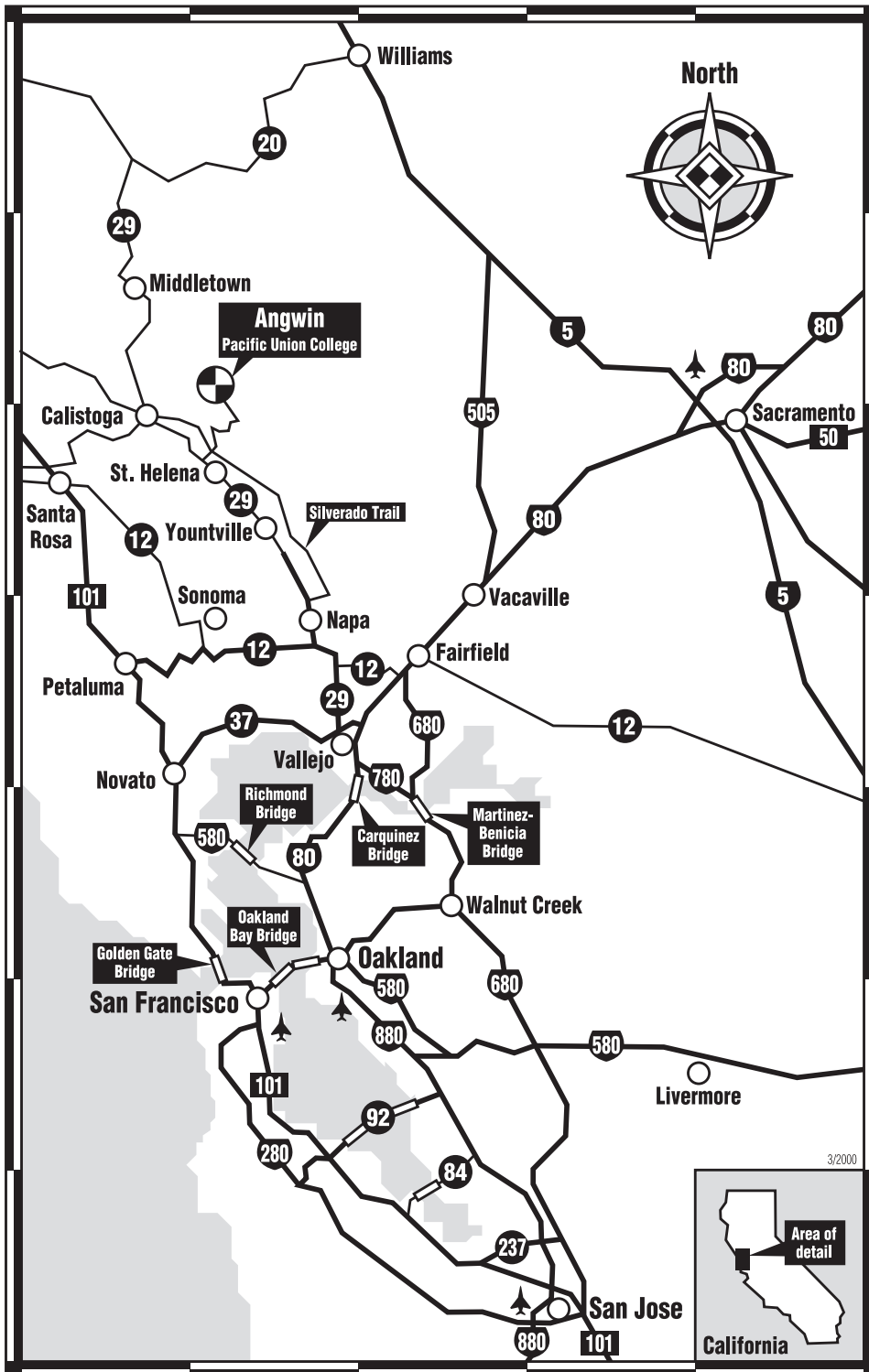
From Sacramento

1. Take **U.S. 80** west toward San Francisco to **HWY 12**.
2. Take **HWY 12** toward Napa to **HWY 29**.
3. Turn right on **HWY 29** and follow directions in number 5 above.

Transportation to PUC

Evans Airport Service offers transportation from the San Francisco International Airport and Oakland International Airport to Napa seven days a week. Evans can be contacted at (707) 255-1559, or on the web at www.evanstransportation.com. Reservations are not required. Only cash or local checks are accepted.

Point of departure at SFO is outside the baggage claim area of your airline at the center divider by the blue striped concrete pillars. Look for the sign for Napa. At Oakland Airport, cross the street outside of the baggage claim area to the Regional Transit shuttle stop (the same row as hotel, rental car, and parking shuttle stops).



Transportation is available from **Napa** to **PUC**. Reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance by calling the enrollment services office at (707) 965-6425.

The **Angwin Airport, Virgil O. Parrett Field**, located directly above the college, is owned and operated by PUC. Tie down, gasoline and oil sale, and mechanical services are available. Runway length: 3,200 feet. For further information, call (707) 965-6219.
