Major or Minor Coursework

If you are taking a major or minor in Spanish, you should plan to complete the following language coursework in Argentina. Please consult with your advisor or review the General Catalog for additional information regarding program requirements.

Major in Spanish Studies: Take at least 30 hours of SPAN courses at the intermediate level or higher. Include at least 24 hours of upper-division coursework.

Major in Language and Culture Studies, Spanish Emphasis: Take at least 30 hours of SPAN courses at the intermediate level or higher. Include at least 24 hours of upper-division coursework.

Minor in Spanish: Take at least 24 hours of SPAN courses at the intermediate level or higher. Include at least 8 hours of upper-division coursework.

Electives

All other courses taken in Argentina will be applied as general electives.
