Major or Minor Coursework

If you are taking a major or minor in German, you should plan to complete the following language coursework in Austria. Please consult with your advisor or review the General Catalog for additional information regarding program requirements.

Major in Language and Culture Studies, German Emphasis: Take at least 30 hours of GRMN courses at the intermediate level or higher. Include at least 12 hours of upper-division coursework.

Minor in German: Take at least 24 hours of GRMN courses at the intermediate level or higher. Include at least 8 hours of upper-division coursework.
