YELLOW RIBBON PROGRAM APPLICATION

Note: Applications are not considered complete without a copy of the Certificate of Eligibility (COE), issued by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), stating that you are 100% eligible for this program. Yellow Ribbon consists of an institutional Yellow Ribbon award from PUC and a matching Yellow Ribbon award from the VA. Due to the difference between the GI Bill benefit year and the start of PUC's academic year, students are not eligible for Yellow Ribbon funding during the Summer quarter. PUC provides one Yellow Ribbon match per academic year, typically applied during the Fall, Winter, and Spring quarters. Yellow Ribbon benefits can only be used after a student has fully exhausted their GI Bill funds within this standard sequence.
